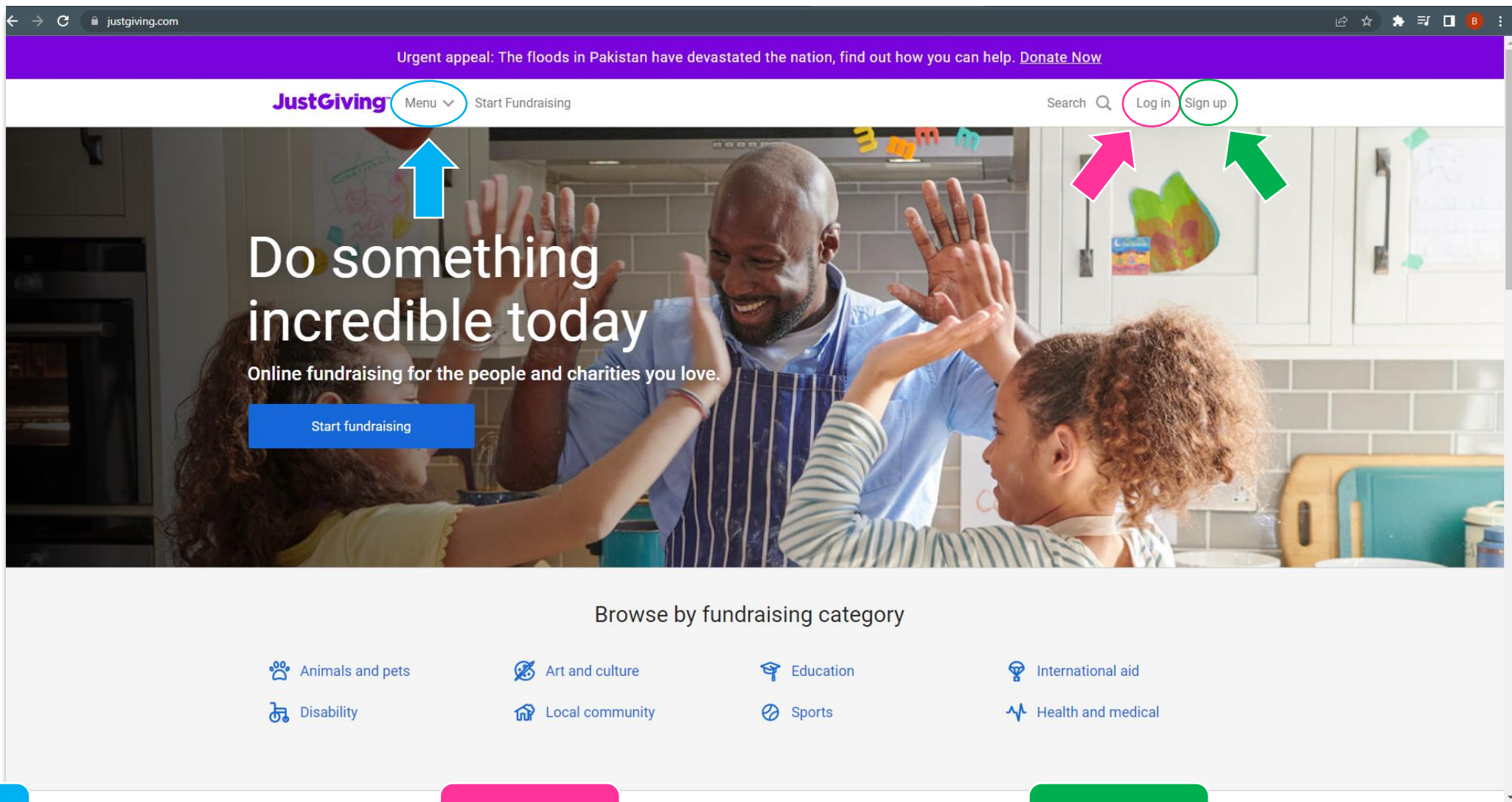


JustGiving: How to Begin Your Fundraiser



Menu

The "Menu" drop-down is the help section. If you're curious about what JustGiving is and how it basically works, the Menu should give a simple explanation.

Login

The 'Log in' button is how you will be able to access your account and fundraiser.

Sign Up

The 'Sign up' button is the first step of your journey on how you will be able to make an account and attach a fundraiser to a campaign that you are raising funds for.

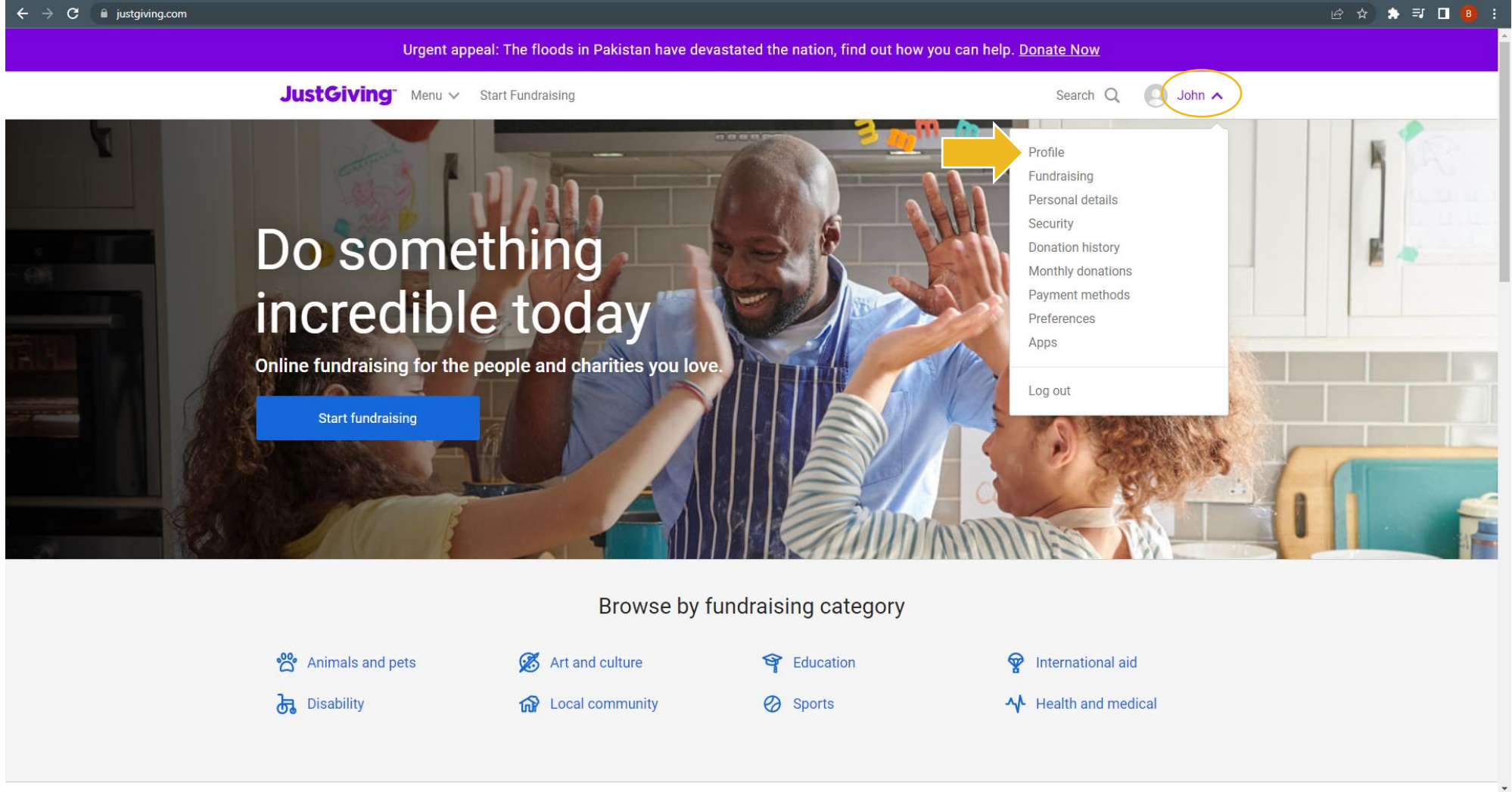

Step 1

Let's go into the 'Sign Up' process. Signing in should be straight-forward.

You put in your name, email, and password. Choose if you would like to receive emails from JustGiving.



Step 2

After you've created an account and signed in, you should be able to click on your profile drop-down that shows your name.

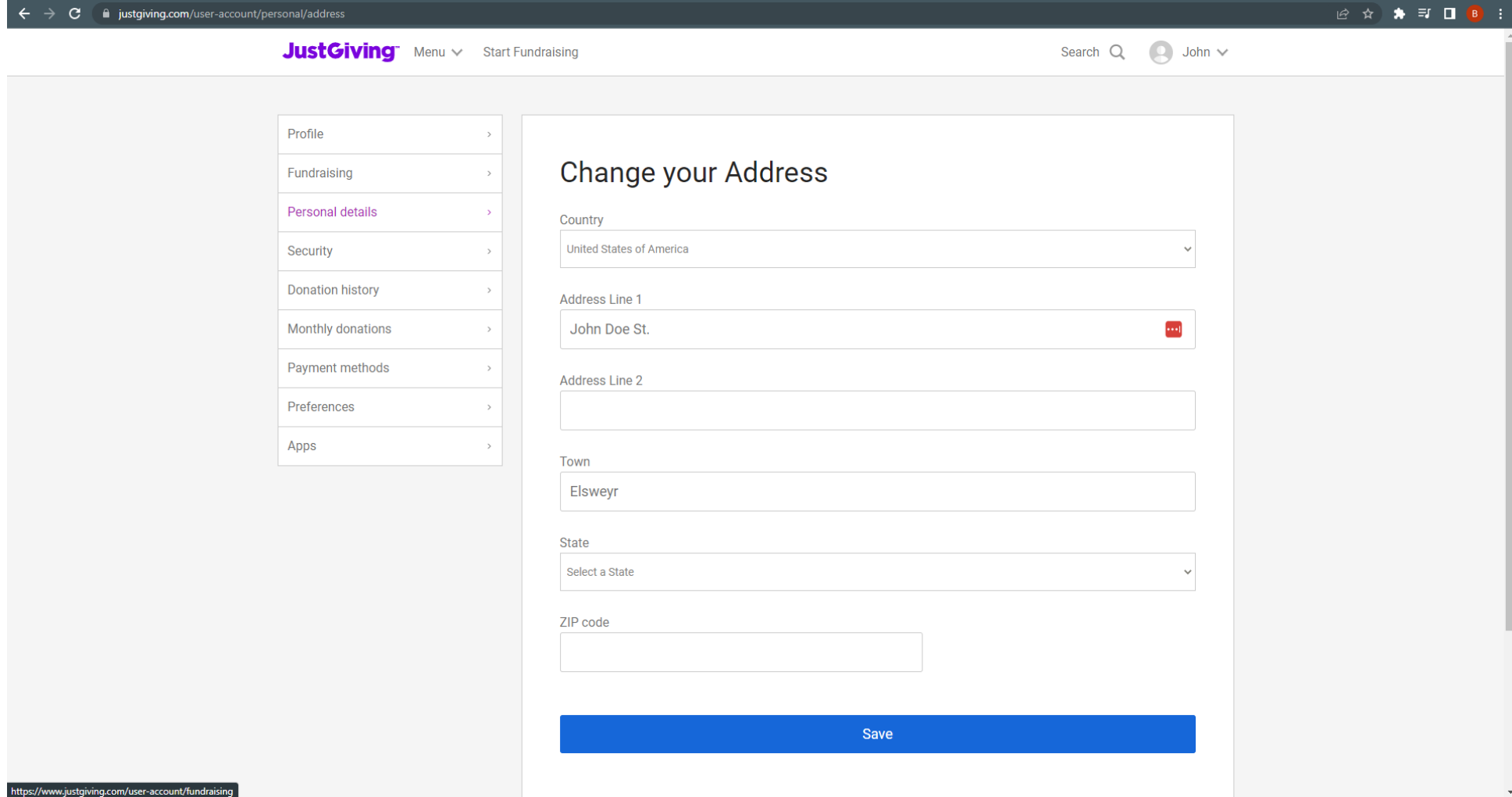

Step 3

On the home page of your profile, you can add a profile picture and see all the categories on your account.

Click the “Personal Details” option to begin completing your profile.



Step 4

In order for you to fundraise, JustGiving will need you to complete your profile information by entering in the fields that's needed.

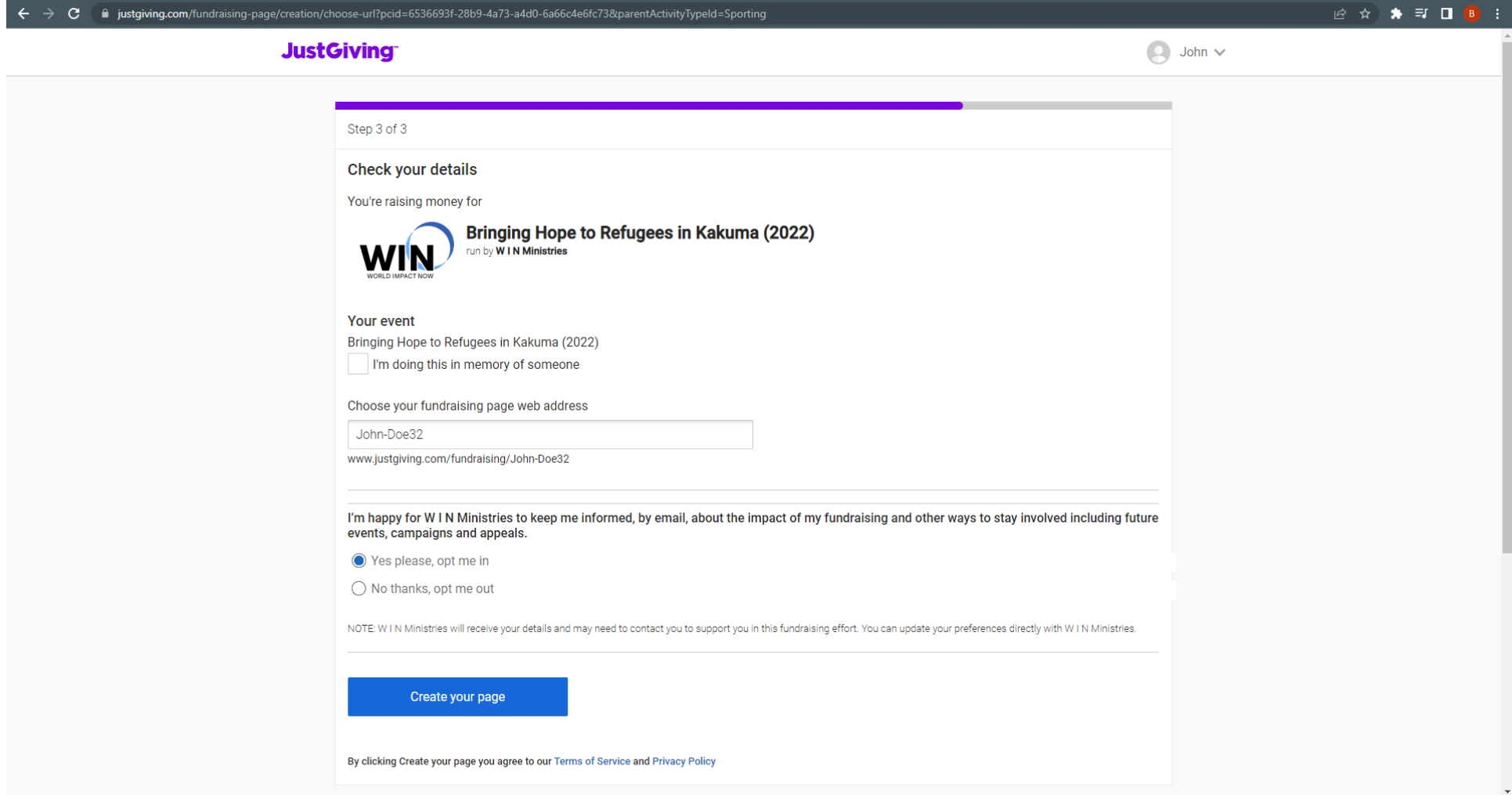

In the search bar, find us under “W I N Ministries” until our name change is processed on JustGiving.

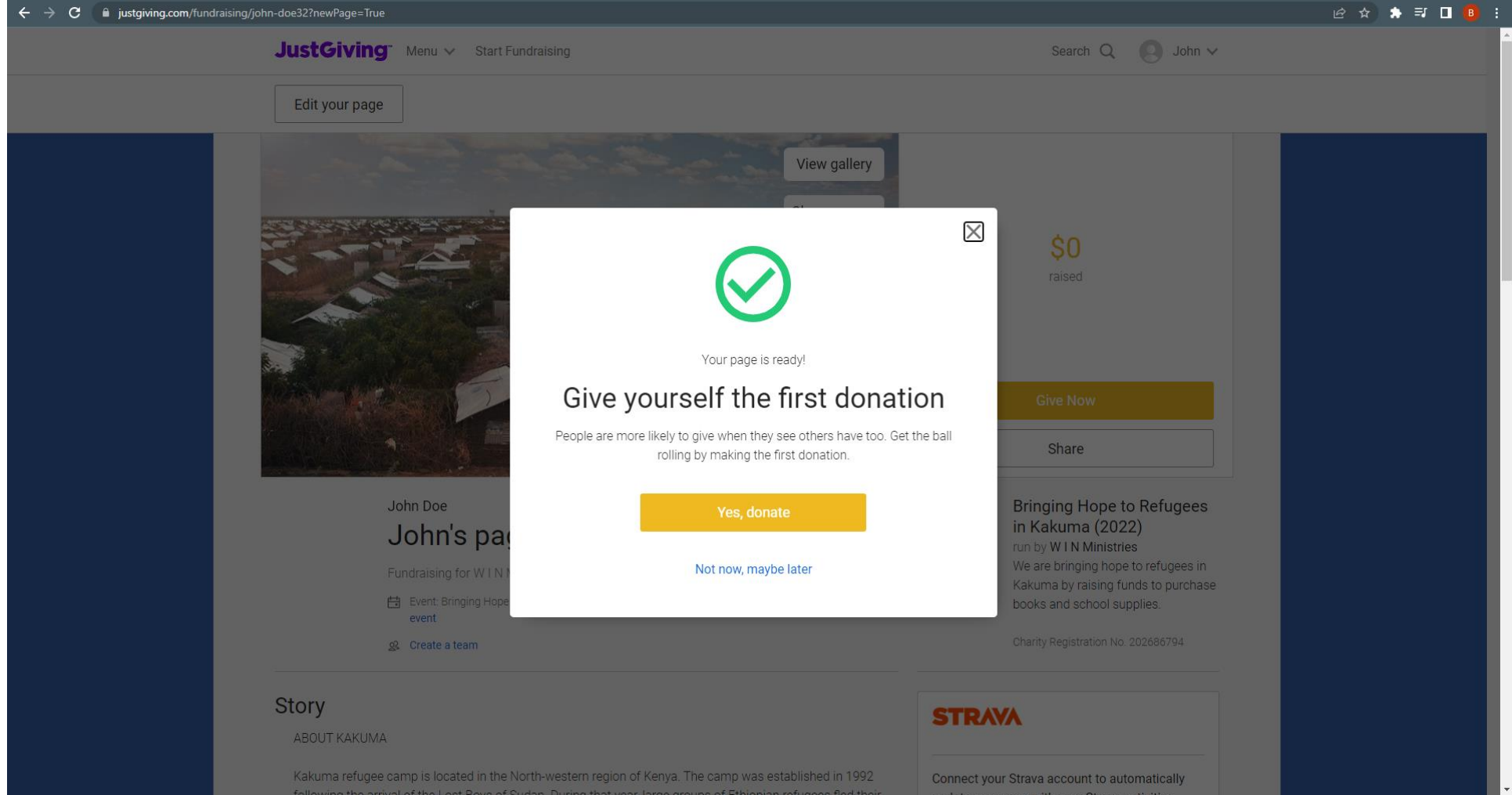
Current campaigns will appear. Choose one to fundraise for or simple navigate to our ministry page and create a fundraising page from there.

The donation you give to your fundraiser will kickstart it, and your donation will encourage others to give as well!

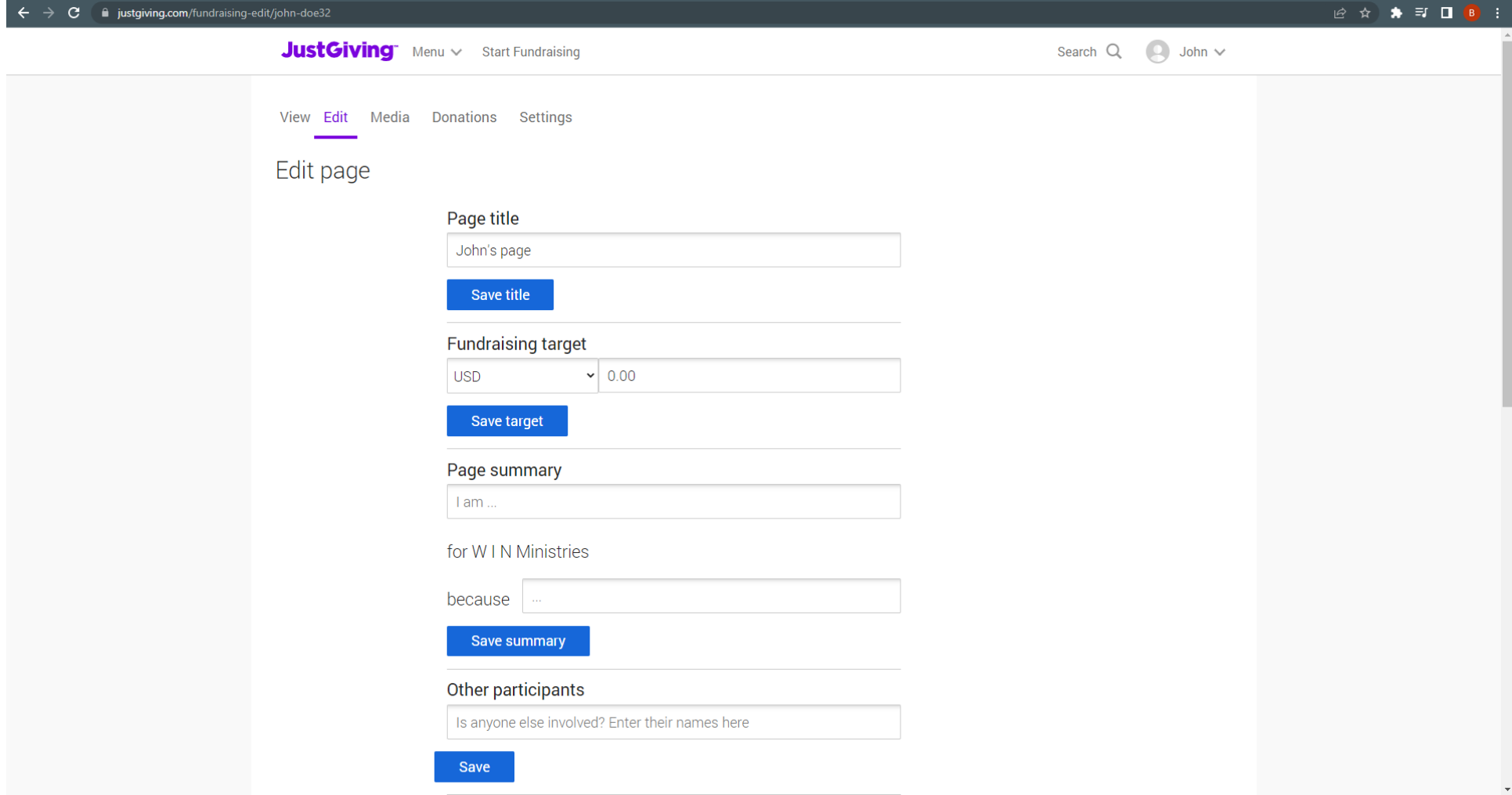

ABOUT KAKUMAKakuma refugee camp is located in the North-western region of Kenya. The camp was established in 1992 following the arrival of the Lost Boys of Sudan. During that year, large groups of Ethiopian refugees fled their country following the fall of the Ethiopian government. Somalia had also experienced high insecurity and civil strife causing people to flee.Kakuma camp and the neighboring Kalobeyei Integrated Settlement had a population of 196,666 registered refugees and asylum-seekers at the end of July 2020.Due to the ongoing conflicts in South Sudan and Ethiopia, and the indeterminate long-term legal status of the refugees, residents of the camp have little hope for a better tomorrow.

Your story is your chance to tell people about yourself, why you care about W I N Ministries, how you are involved with the ministry, and what you are fundraising for.

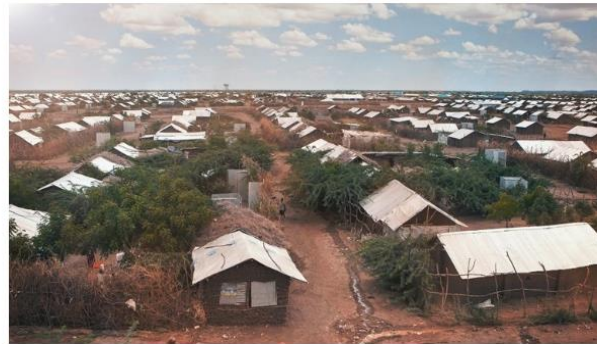
