Solving an Impossible Problem


A majority of the developing world is caught in a vicious cycle that keeps communities closed off to Christ and trapped in poverty. The Christian church often feels like everything they do is only a drop in the ocean of need. There is simply not enough people or money to make a lasting difference.

Through Christ-centered, biblical education, we work to equip, train, and empower leaders to draw people to faith in Christ while breaking cycles of poverty and sickness.

Together, we are building up a church that “goes” into all the world.

STUDENTS GRADUATED

In 2023, we saw **3,559** students graduate and receive their diplomas from Nation-2-Nation Christian University, for a grand total of **16,410** graduates.


INTERNATIONAL TRIPS

Our teams traveled to **32** countries! They attended graduations, hosted facilitator training seminars, and started new schools.

“It was so special to be able to connect with the people in Nicaragua on a spiritual level—even though we didn’t share the same language or culture. TRANSLATION PROGRESS

We crossed several incredible milestones this year with our translation. Our translation teams in Burundi and editors in the United States completed year three of our program in French! And we began working with MegaVoice, an organization specializing in audio translation of the Bible, to translate our N2NCU courses into Mandarin and Hindi!



CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

We had the opportunity to film **8** new courses on topics such as Bible, business, leadership, and discipleship. This culminated in a grand total of **71** sessions filmed!

KEVIN — *Nigeria*








A Mission of Eternal Value

Thanks to our generous partners, 2023 proved to be a record year in our fundraising!

2023 Total: \$508,326

Each gift has pushed forward a mission of eternal value—the spread of the Gospel. Faith in Jesus transforms communities. This is why we aim to ensure donations are used strategically, achieving the mission God has given us and generating the greatest return of souls saved for His Kingdom.

According to Charity Navigator, a reputable nonprofit should spend 25-35% or less on fundraising and administrative costs combined.

Over the last five years, **N2N has spent an average of 86% of all funds directly on our Program Services** (our ministry and work around the world). On average, only 14% has been spent on overhead expenses. Our long-term goal is to consistently spend at least 80% of ministry funds directly on Program Services.
